INTRODUCTION

The **St. Gregorios College of Nursing** is a Christian minority educational institution established, maintained, and administered by **St. Gregorios Medical Mission Hospital, Parumala**. It is multi-specialty, NABH-accredited hospital with 346 beds, including the well-developed **St. Gregorios International Cancer Care Centre**. The College of Nursing, with an annual intake of 60 students for the B.Sc. Nursing programme, was established in **2003**.

Applications are invited for admission to the First Year B.Sc. Nursing Programme (Academic Year 2026–27) under the **NRI Category for nine seats** available in the college, based on the provisions contained in this prospectus. The medium of instruction and examinations shall be **English**. Admission to the 15% of the 9 seats for B.Sc Nursing (4 years) shall be filled on the basis of the merit list prepared as per the marks obtained in the qualifying examinations from the applications received by St.Gregorios College of Nursing as per this prospectus.

This prospectus is subject to modification, addition, or deletion as may be deemed necessary by the college for complying with the regulations of the University, Nursing Councils, other competent statutory authorities, or any further orders of the Hon'ble Courts of Law.

GENERAL INFORMATION

AFFILIATION

1.1 The college is recognized by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) and the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNMC), and is affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Thrissur.

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

In compliance with the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, UGC Regulations, and directives from the Government of Kerala, our institution enforces a strict Zero-Tolerance Policy towards ragging within and outside the campus in all its forms—physical, verbal, psychological, or cyber.

2.1 Ragging/any type of misconduct towards any student either in the college campus or outside will be considered as criminal offence or will be immediately reported to

the police. Perpetrators will not be permitted to continue their studies.

2.2 Every student shall, at the time of admission, furnish a character certificate from the institute wherefrom he/she has passed the qualifying Examination, which would mention the status of his/her behavioral pattern especially in terms as to whether he/she has displayed persistent violent, or aggressive behavior or any desire to harm others.

2.3 Students and parents shall, at the time of admission, furnish a Mandatory anti-ragging online affidavit to the effect that the students will not indulge in any form of ragging.

2.4 The institution has constituted an Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad to monitor, prevent, and act against any reported or observed incidents.

2.5 A 24×7 National Anti-Ragging Helpline is available at 1800-180-5522 and helpline@antiragging.in. Colleges- level reporting mechanisms in place that allow students to reporting incidents, including options for anonymous reporting, allowing individuals to report incidents without revealing their identity.

2.6 Anti-ragging awareness is promoted through orientation programs, public displays, and student mentoring initiatives.

2.7 Disciplinary measures for ragging include fines up to ₹2.5 lakhs, cancellation of admission, expulsion from hostels, and criminal prosecution. We urge students and parents to cooperate fully in maintaining a safe, inclusive, and respectful learning environment.

CODE OF CONDUCT

3.1 Every student is required to adhere strictly to the Code of Conduct of the institution to which he/she is admitted.

FEE STRUCTURE

4.1 Colleges under the Association (AMCSFNCK) has given their proposal for the finalization of the Fee Structure, for this admission batch, before the Fee Regulatory Committee. No decision has yet been taken by the Committee. The fees applicable will be as per the order to be passed by the Committee, even if orders are passed after the

commencement of admissions. The details of the fees charged for the students admitted last year are given below: A selected applicant under the NRI Category is liable to pay the following fees:

As per the Fee Regulatory Committee for Medical Education in Kerala, vide FRC Order No. 50/25/NURSING/AMCSFNCK/PNCMAK dated 10.07.2025, the annual tuition fee payable by students admitted under the NRI Category seats is **Rs. 1,04,500/- (Rupees One Lakh Four Thousand Five Hundred only) per year.**

Note: Apart from the fees specified above, students shall also be required to pay Hostel Fee, Mess Fee, Uniform Fee, and the cost of Textbooks, as applicable. All fees shall be remitted only through Cheque or Online Transfer/NEFT/RTGS/IMPS in favor of St. Gregorios College of Nursing. Cash payment will not be accepted.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO NRI CATEGORY SEATS

- 5.1 The Managements are entitled to fill up to 15% of the total seats as NRI category by admitting qualified students who are dependents of NRIs. According to GO (MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014, “An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father / Mother / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) / Husband/Wife/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother / Half Brother / Half Sister / Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad” will only be eligible to apply in the under NRI category seats.

HOW TO APPLY

- 6.1 All applications shall be submitted **ONLINE only** through the College website: www.parumalanursingcollege.com. Physical documents are **NOT** to be submitted at the office.

BEFORE APPLYING ONLINE, CANDIDATES SHOULD HAVE:

- 6.2 Valid E-mail ID (if you do not have any email address, we recommend preferably a Gmail account).
- 6.3 Scanned copy of recent (taken after first January 2026) passport size colour photograph.
- 6.4 Photograph should be taken in a white/ light coloured background. The image should be in JPEG format. Maximum size for photographs 50 KB and image dimension is 120x150 px. (4.23x5.29 cm).
- 6.5 Upload scanned copy of student's signature taken in a white paper background. The image should be in JPEG format. Maximum size for photograph 50 KB and image dimension is 150x75 px (4x2 cm).
- 6.6 If documents attached are not legible, the application will be rejected.
- 6.7 Scanned copy of the certificates. The image should be in JPEG/PDF format. Maximum size for JPEG/PDF file is 500 KB.

THE DETAILS OF THE APPLICATION FEE PAYMENT-

- 6.8 Application form can be downloaded from the College website from 29/06/2026 onwards.
- 6.9 The application fee is Rs.1200/-(Rupees One Thousand Two Hundred only). Payment can be done by NEFT/RTGS to HDFC Bank, Mannar Branch, A/c Number:50200075949701, IFSC Code: HDFC0004840.
- 6.9 The application form should be completed carefully; furnishing the entire information called for.
- 6.10 Late and incomplete applications and applications not in the prescribed format will be summarily rejected.
- 6.11 Last date of submission of application is 29/07/2026.

CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

7.1 Academic:

- i. As per Indian Nursing Council norms, the candidates should have passed +2 classes with 12 years of school-ship with 50% aggregate in Physics,

Chemistry, Biology and English.

ii. As per norms of Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) for admission for B.Sc Nursing, the minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of: Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course), or Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2), or an equivalent with 12 years schooling from a recognized board or university with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and English with minimum of 50% aggregate marks.

iii. Wherever alphabetical grades like A, B-, C+, etc. are used by the school, appropriate equivalence in terms of percentage like 90%, 75% and 60% should be made available.

iv. Rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.

v. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala, except CBSE and ICSE, shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of the qualifying Examination from Kerala University of Health Sciences/ Directorate of HSE, Kerala.

vi. The norms of eligibility prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council/ Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council/ Kerala University of Health Sciences shall also apply.

vii. For grant of equivalency of Secondary School Educational qualification granted by any foreign country for the purpose of admission to B.Sc Nursing courses, the student need to produce an equivalency certificate from the Association of Indian universities (AIU). AIU House ,16, Commander, Inderjit Gupta Marg, New Delhi- 110002 and also the requisite approval from the Indian Nursing Council.

viii. Every candidate before admission to the course shall submit to the Principal of the Institution a Certificate of Medical Fitness from an authorized Medical Officer with MBBS or higher qualification certifying that the candidate is fit to undergo the course.

7.2 Age: Applicants should complete 17 years of age on or before 31st December 2026. No relaxation of age will be allowed.

7.3 Duration of the programme shall be four years.

7.4 Integrated clinical practice is incorporated with respective practical hours in each semester.

7.5 Scanned copies of certificates / documents to be submitted along with the **online application.**

- a. The relevant page of SSLC book /equivalent board certificate as proof of age and date of birth.
- b. Certificate and Mark list of qualifying examination (Plus Two/12th std.) or printout of the result sheet from the website.
- c. Eligibility/ Equivalency Certificate from Kerala University of Health Sciences/ Directorate of HSC, Kerala, wherever if applicable.
- d. Scanned copy of application fee payment RTGS/NEFT counterfoil.

7.6 While reporting for the **admission, all the relevant certificates / documents in **original** as listed below should be submitted to the institution:**

- i. The relevant page of School Leaving Certificate (SSLC book)/equivalent board certificate as proof of age and date of birth.
- ii. Certificate and Mark list of SSLC /10th Std.
- iii. Certificate and Marklist of qualifying Examination (Plus Two /12thStd).
- iv. Certificate of good conduct from the institution last attended (preferably issued within six months).
- v. Eligibility/Equivalency Certificate if applicable.
- vi. Course and Conduct Certificate.
- vii. Transfer Certificate (T.C).
- viii. Migration Certificate, if applicable.
- ix. Nativity Certificate.
- x. Anti-ragging Certificate–Conduct certificate from the Head of Institution last studied in proof of Clause 2.2 of the prospectus.
- xi. Copy of Photo ID Proof (Aadhaar/VotersID/Passport).
- xii. Copy of the format of the online application form.
- xiii. Photographs (Passportsize 6 Nos & stamp size 2 Nos).
- xiv. Additionally, two sets of photocopies of all the certificates /documents attested by Gazatted officers have to be submitted at the time of admission.

PROOF FOR NRI STATUS

An applicant, who depends upon his / her Father/Mother/ Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins)/ Husband/ Wife/ Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother/ Half Brother/ Half Sister /Adopted Father or Adopted Mother working abroad is eligible to apply under NRI quota. (As per the G.O (MS) No.243/2014/ H&FWD dated 06.08.2014). Candidates who seek admission under NRI quota in Private Self Financing

Nursing colleges should upload documents/certificates as per G.O. (Rt) 375/2020/H&FWD dated.22.02.2020 & G.O (Rt) No.1480/2022/H&FWD dated: 22.06.2022.

The following documents shall be uploaded for NRI Quota reservation (As per G.O.No. 375/ 2020/ H& FWD, Dated 22.02.2020 and G.O (Rt) No.1480/2022/H&FWD, Dated 22.06.2022).

8.1 Passport copy and Visa attested by the Embassy or Consulate authorities/Green Card/ Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) documents of their respective sponsors. The job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents.

8.2 The visa of the Sponsor should be valid till the closing date of admission in respect of Medical and Medical Allied courses.

8.3 In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents, the candidate has to produce the Employment Certificate of the Sponsor attested by the Embassy/Consulate authorities.

8.4 The Certificates clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the Revenue authorities as per the G.O (MS) No. 243/ 14/ H&FWD dated 06.08.2014.

8.5 Note:

a. Relationship should clearly be established. In case relationship is mentioned as Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt only in the space provided for in the certificate, the Village Officer should give an explanation of the relation in the certificate itself. Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt should be explained with clear relationship. The relationship link should be clearly explained. Certificates showing mere Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt without establishing clear relationship link will be rejected. Candidates shall verify the certificate properly before submitting online.

b. Directives of AFRC from time to time will be applicable to the NRI documents subject to the Government Orders.

8.6 However the relationship between the candidate and his/her father/mother which are recorded in the educational certificates maintained in the usual course of transaction by the competent authorities shall be accepted.

8.7 The candidate shall produce the sworn affidavit from the Sponsor in a stamp paper worth Rs.200/-.The same shall also be notarized by the Notary Public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and all expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the

Sponsor. (Annexure- I Format enclosed).

- 8.8 Validity of Visa - equivalent documents indicating visa validity, such as Civil ID, Resident Permit, Resident ID, IQAMA, Electronic Visa, Employment Pass, or Entry Visa may be considered.
- 8.9 If any document attested by the Embassy/Consulate General of India mentions visa validity, such documents may be considered.
- 8.10 If the sponsor's visa states 'Housewife' or 'Student' as the employment status, the corresponding Employment Certificate may be considered valid if it is properly attested.

PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION, ALLOTMENT & ADMISSION

Rank lists of all applicants shall be prepared and published on the website, www.parumalanursingcollege.com, based on the total percentage of marks obtained in the core subjects of the qualifying examination.

Merit based Selection

Candidate will be selected strictly on **Merit basis only**. A Rank list for B.Sc nursing will be prepared based on the aggregate percentage of marks obtained in English, Physics, and Chemistry & Biology in the Second year examination - qualifying examination. The marks obtained for the qualifying exam will be subjected to normalization process. The marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various boards or authority shall be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying Examination conducted by the Director of HSE, Kerala, by adopting the method of normalization.

Publication of Rank list

The Rank list will be published on the website on 01/08/2026 as per the admission schedule. Based on this mark list, the first 9 students will be selected for admission and the remaining 10 students will be placed in the 1st waiting list. If the seats remain vacant after considering the first waiting list, second waiting list will be published for the admission process. If seats are still vacant, further, the same selection process will be followed.

- 9.1 If an applicant does not take admission on getting online allotment, she/he will lose all future claims for admission in the subsequent allotments.
- 9.2 An applicant who receives an online allotment will have to join the college within the notified date and time schedule by submitting the original documents and remitting the fees payable to the college.

- 9.3 All applicants shall follow the admission schedule as notified in the prospectus as well as regularly visit the website www.parumalanursingcollege.com to know further updates.
- 9.4 While reporting for admission, all the relevant certificates /documents in original should be submitted to the Principal of the Institution.
- 9.5 All students who get selected should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis B and Covid-19. A certificate to the effect shall be produced at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.
- 9.7 Every student is required to adhere strictly to the Code of Conduct of the College.
- 9.8 Without prejudice to the directions of the Nursing Council /Government /University, the decision of St **Gregorios Medical Mission Hospital management** shall be final on all matters with regard to admission.

CANCELLATION OF ADMISSIONS AND REFUND/ ADJUSTMENT TO FEES

10.1 As per the regulations of the University and Nursing Council, admissions will have to be closed by 30th September of the year of admission. If any student intends to discontinue the studies before or after this date, it will be necessary for such student to give a notice in writing to the principal of the college at least by **24/09/2026, 3 p.m.** The notice should be received in person by the principal or by his representative, authorized to receive such notice.

10.2 Candidates who express their intention to discontinue their studies in the Pharmacy College by giving due intimation before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. Student who discontinues the course will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent Civil Court. Claim by the management for liquidated damages against the student will not be a ground to withhold the original certificates of the student.

10.3 Besides, all candidates who opt to discontinue the course any time before completion of the course will have to pay hostel, mess and other fees proportionately for the period they remained on the rolls of the college. Furnishing of false information/ particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of

admission to the course, if admitted and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

11 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the nursing college before the last date fixed for closure of admission will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the college at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the college midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent “Civil Court.”
